Maths

Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

- Practise counting out loud forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s and 10s. Collect objects and sort them into groups of 2s, 5s or 10s before counting. What happens if the total number of objects is not in the 2, 5 or 10 times tables?
